Overview of the role

We are seeking an experienced and forward-thinking **Network Operational Systems Lead** to lead the delivery and maintenance of Network Waitaki's operational technology (OT) systems, including SCADA and ADMS. This role plays a key part in ensuring that our OT environment remains secure, resilient, and future-ready to support a smarter, more responsive electricity network.

Key responsibilities

Operational Technology and System Administration

- Administer and support the Advanced Distribution Management System (ADMS) to maintain high operational readiness.
- Manage and configure Intelligent Electronic Devices (IEDs) and SCADA controls, ensuring reliable performance across the network.
- Lead the implementation and maintenance of communications infrastructure which will enable Network Waitaki's smart grid.
- Collaborate with IT to ensure seamless integration while considering cybersecurity and lifecycle support of operational systems.

Data Integrity and Model Management

- Maintain and validate network models, ensuring accuracy of GIS system connectivity data and user interfaces.
- Perform device mapping and ensure standards-based implementation of system components.
- Maintain clear, structured documentation of data models, configuration standards, and related procedures.

System Development and Enhancement

- Develop, test, and implement system enhancements, including coding, database queries, and dashboard reporting.
- Identify and document opportunities for continuous improvement in systems and processes including automation and streamlining of manual tasks.
- Contribute to Network Waitaki's long-term operational systems roadmap.
- Maintain clear and well-structured documentation of procedures and standards.

Stakeholder Coordination

- Liaise with contractors and vendors to ensure effective delivery of works aligned with technical and operational standards.

- Take responsibility for own health and safety and support the team to safe work outcomes.
